

Major Chords

A major chord has three notes: the root, the major third, and the fifth. Use this chart to find the letter names in each major chord.

ROOT - MAJOR THIRD - FIFTH

C Major

C - E - G

Db Major

Db - F - Ab

D Major

D - F# - A

Eb Major

Eb - G - Bb

E Major

E - G# - B

F Major

F - A - C

Gb Major

Gb - Bb - Db

G Major

G - B - D

Ab Major

Ab - C - Eb

A Major

A - C# - E

Bb Major

Bb - D - F

B Major

B - D# - F#

Enharmonic note: Db can also be called C#, Eb can also be called D#, Gb can also be called F#, Ab can also be called G#, and Bb can also be called A#.
