

Minor Chords

A minor chord has three notes: the root, the minor third, and the fifth. Use this chart to find the letter names in each minor chord.

ROOT - MINOR THIRD - FIFTH

C Minor
C - Eb - G

C# Minor
C# - E - G#

D Minor
D - F - A

Eb Minor
Eb - Gb - Bb

E Minor
E - G - B

F Minor
F - Ab - C

F# Minor
F# - A - C#

G Minor
G - Bb - D

G# Minor
G# - B - D#

A Minor
A - C - E

Bb Minor
Bb - Db - F

B Minor
B - D - F#

Enharmonic note: C# can also be called Db, Eb can also be called D#, F# can also be called Gb, G# can also be called Ab, and Bb can also be called A#.
